Diadhuit from Ireland!

It seems as if a long time has passed since I left New Zealand soil to begin my missionary adventure in Ireland. My first week here was spent with the NET musicians. Each day was filled with praise and worship – either playing guitar, praising or learning how to lead others in worship. The rest of the missionaries arrived the following week and we all travelled down to a town close to Galway where we spent a couple of weeks on retreat, on a journey of personal spiritual growth with Jesus. We then travelled back up to Rosstown to complete our training on all the practical aspects of youth ministry: giving talks/testimonies, team and ministry life, dramas, relating to young people and how to integrate ourselves into the Irish culture, to name a few.

My team of 5 missionaries has been placed in the Booterstown parish in Dublin for the year. Everyone we have met so far has been very welcoming, friendly and excited to see what a NET team can bring to the parish. With this support, we have been able to start up a junior and senior youth group, as well as running confirmation and Religious Education classes. We have also run several retreats for a couple of schools. We are very excited to continue growing the youth ministry in the parish and the surrounding schools.

The tools I have found most beneficial in my time here have been personal prayer, team prayer and daily Mass. Without this dependence on God for His providence and protection, we wouldn't be able to complete the work He has given us.
