I never met my grandparents. When mum and dad left the Philippines, they left everything behind: family, friends, comforts, and familiar surroundings.

As I grew up in Christchurch, not once did they return home to their homeland. In 2015 (the year I was on placement here at Christ the King) we went over to the Philippines; the first time for us kids and for the first time in 26 years for my parents. It was an amazing experience! What made the trip amazing was the fact that we were able to connect with our cousins, aunties, and uncles. Even though we were able to meet our extended family, there was a certain sadness in not having been able to meet our grandparents.

During November, the Church has a great tradition in which we pray for and remember our loved ones who have died. It's this remembrance that is key. In our Catholic Liturgical celebrations, remembrance is not just about looking back to the past, but also looking ahead to the future in trust and hope. Just as our loved ones shared in Christ's death in baptism, we believe that they will share in Christ's resurrection and enjoy eternal life in God's presence.

During November there will be a box by the altar. You are invited to write on a piece of paper the names of your loved ones who have died, and place it in the box. They will be offered at each Mass in November.

I will continue to pray for my grandparents, especially during this month, and no doubt they will be praying for me too.
