- **Please dress appropriately.**
- **Approach the altar promptly at the end of the Sign of Peace and bow your head at the foot of the altar steps.**
- **Cleanse your hands with the hand sanitiser at either side of the altar.**
- **Look at the raised Host when the priest says “Behold the Lamb of God”.**
- **Give Communion first to the people in wheelchairs or with crutches etc. sitting in the front row.**
- **If you are distributing the Body of Christ**

At the side, stand by the holy water font.

When saying “The Body of Christ” look at the Host. Do not address the person by name.

If a little child or anyone with their arms crossed approaches, place your hand on their shoulder and say “God Bless You.”

If you drop a Host pick it up and consume it or place it in your hand to consume later.

If you run out of Hosts ask another minister for some.

When you have finished distributing the Body of Christ at the side, go to the center and help distribute there.

When you have finished go behind the altar and place the bowl or ciborium on the corporal (white cloth in middle of altar) then cleanse your fingers at the side and proceed to the foot of the steps and wait there. Do not remain at the altar.

- **If you are distributing the Precious Blood**

Stand side by side beneath the speakers.

If a child approaches and the chalice is full you may need to help them hold the chalice.

After giving the chalice to a communicant wipe it with the cloth and turn it slightly.

If you spill the Precious Blood collect the bowl of water and cloth from the table, pour water on the spillage, soak it up with the cloth, pour more water on and soak it up with the second cloth. Put bowl and cloths in the sacristy.

If you are distributing at the side and the chalice is empty remain in your position until distribution of Communion is finished. When distribution of Communion is finished those with the chalices go and stand at the side of the altar. After the priest has placed the ciborium in the tabernacle put your chalice and cloth on the corporal, cleanse your fingers at the side then proceed to the foot of the altar steps and wait there. Do not consume remaining Precious Blood unless asked to do this by the priest.

- **When all EMHC are at the foot of the steps, bow together and return to your seat.**
 - **At our weekend masses we have 8 people distributing communion. Normally this is the priest and 7 EMHC. If there is more than one priest less EMHC will be required.**
